EVENT DESCRIPTION:	<p>The session started at 12.00 am.</p> <p>Professor Luca Verzichelli presents the points that will be discussed during the call with the partners.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The first important issue concerns the dissemination of PACTUM activities on the project's social networks/website. The partners decided to keep two social accounts updated: Facebook and Instagram Accounts. Each activity will be regularly posted on these accounts to reach the largest possible audience. Each partner and Institution will also share information on their platforms/social channels.



- Updates about accreditation procedures: Ministry dates for approval are in March.

UCAR and UTM: apply in due time in March. The maquette and every other document needed are ready to submit the program to the University's internal scientific council. UTM will be ready at the beginning of February | UCAR has already received approval from their internal scientific council.

USFAX: is waiting for the next university's scientific council the approval.

This partner asks for a supporting letter from the University of Siena – letter d'appui - (maybe also with the other European partners) to support their application for an international project (EN/FR).

In this document, the universities will annex the Partner Agreement concerning the PACTUM project and a *convention spécifique* in case of *co-diplomation* as for UCAR and UTM.

USOUSSE: The master program's template is filled, and the CV is designed with the contribution of the Department of Law and Political Science. They need approval from their internal scientific council to send their application to the MHESR and be ready before March 2023.

UK: They are waiting for approval from their internal scientific council and then will send their application to the MHESR in March 2023.

Partners will notify the coordinators when proceeding with these documents or/and if they need supporting documents

- Training session in Sousse: 16/19 February 2023 – The University of Sousse oversees the logistic details with the cooperation of our UNIMED partner.

Each Tunisian partner will attend the training session with a team composed of 5 people maximum.

UNISI will send two members on February 16, whereas the coordinator will join the session on Feb 18.

UGRA: They won't be able to attend the session in person but will provide an intervention online (Zoom) with people involved in International Projects/Online Masters/Internships.

UMON: They will provide online presentations as well.



UNIMED → Suggests that this training session should be focused on the master's topics, especially where there is a gap in teacher's formations. UNIMED staff won't be able to attend in person but they could find some experts who would attend the Sousse training session in person.

The University of Sousse will collect all the presentation proposals of the Tunisian partners in order to finalize the whole session's program. During these days a brief discussion about the state of the arts concerning some deliverables (2.2 | 2.3 | 2.5) and the PACTUM Master's logistic details will be included.

- Summer school taking place in June 2023. All partners theoretically agree about it, except the University of Kairouan which prefers to hold it in September 2023.
