



1. What's ethnography?

- Maximum **depth**, one or few cases
- **Observation** and immersion (longer periods)
- Main strengths:
 - Observation of non-verbal practice
 - Everyday discourses and relationships



2. Challenges and difficulties

- The **uniqueness** of the case
- **Reflexivity**
- Delivery of **results**
- **Ethical** issues



2.1 The uniqueness of the case

- Few cases/one case
- **Deviant** cases
- “Extended case method”
(Burawoy, 1998)



2.2 The labor of reflexivity

- “**Objectivation**” (Bourdieu, 1996)
- Researcher’s role on fieldwork
- Assumptions and prenotions regarding the study object

2.3 Delivery of results

- Devolution of findings
- Different forms (discussing reports with interviewees, presenting findings to participants)
- **Feedback**
- **Validity** of interpretations

2.4 Ethical issues

- Ethical committees, information and **consent**
- “One size fits all” (Russell and Barley, 2020)
- Ethics as a **continuous process**...
- Impact and **damage** on participants
