EVENT DESCRIPTION:	
<p>The session started at 10.00.</p> <p>The Pixel team introduced the contents of the meeting starting with a short presentation of the evaluation strategy which consists of applying qualitative and quantitative indicators to evaluate expected outcomes and results. The process was carried out through evaluation questionnaires submitted to the project partners and the evaluation resulted in a score between 7 and 8, thus is considered “Good”.</p> <p>The second part of the meeting was devoted to a SWOT analysis conducted online with the participants attending the meeting, through the Padlet platform. The participants have been</p>	



asked to identify the point of strength of the project development and challenges/risks/opportunities. Screenshots of the collected answers are available on the PACTUM website's section dedicated to this meeting.

The Pixel team devoted a third moment of the meeting to circulate their core recommendations and suggestions, mainly concerning the shape and contents of the PACTUM website plus some of the deliverables that still have to be completed or adjusted.

The fourth and last part of this meeting explored the evaluation of the activities conducted in the framework of the project. This analysis was conducted through the presentation of the results connected to each working package. As concerns the WP1 *Preparation* the two reports "Needs Analysis" and "Catalogue of Best Practices" were carried out correctly but still need translations. As concerns the WP2, *Summer Schools, and Master Co-Design*, the deliverable was addressed with good results, except for the "Recruitment strategy guidelines" which will be carried out by the end of June 2023. The same applies to the WP4, *Summer Schools* excepted the final evaluation report which will be produced considering the progress report written in the last year, together with the results that will collect this summer at the end of the third annual cycle of summer schools. WP5, *Quality*, was excellently carried out through the design of a good quality plan and questionnaires. The data collected are presented in a report available on the "Result" section of the PACTUM website both in English and French. WP6, *Dissemination*, still lacks the organization of a sufficient number of dissemination events that we will provide by the end of the project. A PACTUM newsletter is a work in progress, and the communication plan is under review by the PACTUM consortium to comply with the indications provided by both external evaluators and EACEA. The WP7, *Management*, has been carried out correctly and with good results.
