WELCOME NOTE

No pain no gain. It has been hard to wait almost two years to know each other. It has been upsetting to organize dozens of online calls with no chance to socialize with the partners of the project for such a long time. However, we did not surrender. We have built a wide network and we have opened several lines of collaboration among European and Tunisian academics during 2021 and 2022. The first cycle of Summer Schools was entirely held online. The second cycle was organized in a blended mode but the mobility of teachers (especially from Europe to Tunisia) and students was seriously undermined until the second half of 2022.



Finally, we had, for the first time, the chance to meet in person (in Tunis, General Assembly of May 2022) and we have then started a number of activities in the preparation of the master program – the main academic output of the project. In particular, the two Training sessions held in Siena (November 2022) and Sousse (February 2023).

This series of Newsletters we are launching to accompany the final period of the project has the goal to disseminate the outreach and the experiences of this project which still has to express its enormous potential of impact. We want to create impact on students, first of all. But also, we think that our activities have a fundamental impact in terms of improvement of our curricula and teaching methods in both the sides of the Mediterranean sea. Which means, after all, impact on our Higher Education Institutions and our scientific communities.

Moreover, we can create positive impact and strengthen our cooperation with non-academic organizations, associations, Non-governing and governing institutions, media and public intellectuals.

The first issue of this agile newsletter is devoted to the account of the first phase of the Pactum project. Namely, the phase of preparation of the first two cycle of summer schools – almost entirely characterised by virtual communication and online calls. We will recount, in short, the activities preceding the Siena General Conference and Training Session of November 2022. In the next issues will provide more in-depth memories and reflections about our recent activities and the prospective ones. In particular, the next cycle of summer schools (to be held between June and October 2023).

PACTUM PROJECT

PACTUM is a capacity-building project aiming to develop a high-quality, multi-disciplinary and stimulating program in social, political and behavioral sciences. The target country of this project is Tunisia, a key partner for European Union Higher Education Institutions. Tunisian universities have recently undergone a remarkable transformation, which is bound to, and complements, the processes of modernization and democratization of the political system.

Academic cooperation in a delicate and rapidly evolving field like that of social sciences and in particular those disciplines which are central to the formation of future ruling classes and higher civil servants is a crucial test for prospective cooperation among Tunisian HEIs and European HEIs engaging with capacity building activities.

PACTUM GOALS

The goals of this project consisted in the exchange of degree planning experiences in the field of social sciences, the organization of preparatory summer schools, the design of a vocational master's course and the involvement of social actors and public administration and, finally, to converge on the crucial need to boost positive impact on students to gain mutual enrichment between European and Tunisian academics. In this perspective, the project mainly targets four groups in Tunisia: students, teaching staff, public employees, and engaged civil society.

Pactum's main outcome so far consisted in three annual cycles of five summer schools dedicated to sustainability, good governance and public administration, democratic theories, and participation in the Mediterranean area. On the way forward instead, a Master's program in social and behavioural sciences is our main expected outcome for the next months. All these activities have been and will be held by the five Tunisian universities also involving three of the European partners: the University of Siena, the University of Montpellier and the University of Granada.

PACTUM KICK-OFF MEETING

On Monday 22 February at 9 a.m. -1 p.m. (CET) all PACTUM partners enjoyed to meet in our kickoff meeting, Prof. Luca Verzichelli introduced the project aims and objectives, and we talked about Academic Cooperation in the Mediterranean Area and the Experience of Granada and we made a Round table with representatives from Tunisian Universities.








PACTUM ONLINE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
